

Timothy Hulbert

Timothy Hulbert, IOM, was selected as President & Chief Executive Officer of the Charlottesville Regional Chamber of Commerce in March 2001. Mr. Hulbert holds the professional designation, "IOM," from the *Institute for Organization Management* (at Villanova University), the nation's premier professional organization management program administered by the US Chamber of Commerce.



Mr. Hulbert is active in the Virginia Association of Chamber of Commerce Executives, a network of nearly 100 Virginia regional and local Chambers of Commerce. He has served as the VAACE Board President in 2013-14 and in that capacity, also serves on the Board of Directors of the Virginia Chamber of Commerce. He received the VACCE "Virginia Chamber Executive of the Year Award" in 2006.

Prior to coming to Charlottesville, for 12 years Mr. Hulbert served as President & CEO of the Rensselaer County (NY) Regional Chamber of Commerce and its Rensselaer Gateway Development Corporation affiliate. Before his career as a Chamber executive, he served on the executive staff of two New York State Transportation Commissioners, James Larocca and Franklin White, in the administration of Governor Mario M. Cuomo. In the 1970's, his public service also included service on the executive staff of New York State Energy Commissioner James Larocca in the administration of Governor Hugh L. Carey and as a Special Assistant to United States Congressman Ned Pattison (NY-29). In business Mr. Hulbert was a financial services consultant and manager with Equitable. He also worked as a professional communications and marketing consultant with Envision Communications, where he continues to consult on specialized accounts.

Mr. Hulbert grew up in Greene County New York and is a graduate of Christian Brothers Academy in Albany and Manhattan College (BA – Government).
